SPECIAL AGREEMENT SUBMITTED TO THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE BY THE REPUBLIC OF UHTRED AND THE REPUBLICS OF THYRA, STORI, SIGEFRID & BEOCCA ON THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THEM CONCERNING VIOLATIONS OF INTERNATIONAL LAW, INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS LAW, STATE SOVEREIGNTY AND INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAW.

The Republic of Uhtred and the Republics of Thyra, Stori, Sigefrid & Beocca;

Considering that differences have risen amongst them regarding armed activities in the Republic of Uhtred,

Recognizing that the parties have been unable to settle their differences through negotiation, desiring that the International Court of Justice, hereinafter referred to as “the Court,” consider these differences and settle the dispute.

In furtherance thereof, the parties have concluded the following special agreement:

Article I

The Republic of Uhtred and the Republics of Thyra, Sigefrid, Beocca and Stori, hereinafter referred to as “the Parties” shall submit the questions contained in this Special Agreement to the Court pursuant to Article 40, paragraph 1 of the Statute of the International Court of Justice.

Article II

It is agreed by the parties that Uhtred shall act as Applicant and the Republics of Thyra, Sigefrid, Beocca and Stori as Respondents, but such agreement is without prejudice to any question of the burden of proof.

Article III

- (a). The court is requested to decide this matter on the basis of the rules and principles of general international law, as well as any applicable treaties.
- (b). The Court is also requested to determine the legal consequences, including the rights and obligations of the Parties, arising from any judgment on the questions presented in this matter.

Article IV

- (a). The written pleadings shall consist of memorials to be submitted simultaneously to the Court by the Parties not later than the date officially communicated by the President of the Court.
- (b). Procedures shall be regulated in accordance with the applicable Rules and provisions for the 2020 Kenya Model United Nations International Court of Justice Moot Court Competition

Article V

- (a). The Parties shall accept the Judgment of the Court as final and binding upon them and shall execute it in its entirety and in good faith.
- (b). Immediately after the transmission of the Judgment, the Parties shall enter into negotiations on the modalities for its execution.

This Special Agreement shall enter into force upon signature.
